FAQs AND PROPER CARE INSTRUCTIONS

1 HOW TO USE

- Chill canister as well as the desired ingredient. Chilling will help you get better results.
- Once chilled, pour desired ingredient into the canister but make sure not to over fill it.
- To assemble, place gasket inside the head and screw head on to canister evenly and firmly.
- Insert the N20 cartridge into the aluminum charger holder then screw the aluminum charger holder on to the inlet valve until the charger content is released with a hissing sound.
- Whip your cream!



2 CLEANING YOUR CREAM WHIPPER

- Allow remaining pressure to escape by pressing the lever.
- Unscrew the head and the decorating nozzle.
- Thoroughly clean each component with mild detergent and brush. When drying, make sure head and canister are separated.
- Do not to put it into boiling water nor in the dishwasher as some dishwasher detergents tend to be very strong.



3 TYPES OF INGREDIENT TO USE

- Cream Whipper is made to use only for soluble ingredients. Insoluble substances such as seeds, pulp etc. prevent the closure of the delivery valve or might impair its functionality.
- For sweetening, it is best to use powdered or liquid sweeteners. Granulated sugar or salt must first be dissolved in water or milk.



4 MATERIALS AND WHERE IS IT MADE

- Innovee Home Cream Whipper is made in China.
- It is made with high-grade brushed aluminum which is built to last for years and years of use.



5 SAFETY MEASURES

- Do not use sharp or abrasive materials when cleaning.
- Do not put cream whipper into the dishwasher.
- Never place cream whipper in a freezing compartment or freezer.
- Do not expose it to heat, boiling water, sun, microwave etc.
- Open the Cream Whipper when the pressure has completely escaped. Press the lever until the hissing sound stops.
- Do not use force. All parts are easily assembled.
- For long term storage, please keep head and bottle separately.
