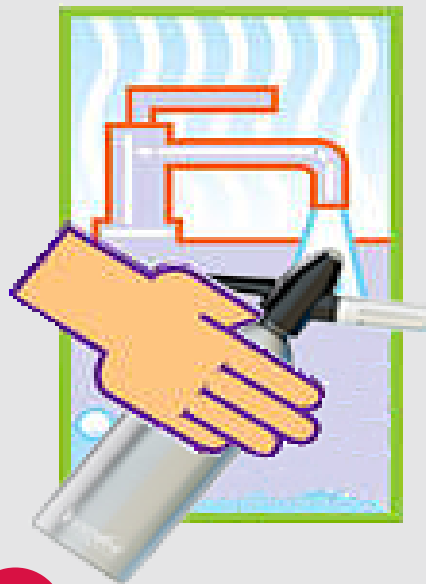


# A QUICK GUIDE, TIPS & FAQ'S ABOUT YOUR NEW INNOVEE HOME SODA SIPHON



## 1 USING YOUR SODA FOR THE FIRST TIME

- Check all parts. Make sure they are complete and free from damage.
- Fill your soda siphon with water to at least two-thirds of the the bottle. Use cold water for best results.
- Insert the fill tube before inserting the long plastic fork. Once done, properly seal it into the top of the bottle.
- In clockwise direction, **FIRMLY SCREW THE HEAD OF THE SIPHON.** Do not over-tighten.
- **DO NOT ATTEMPT TO REMOVE THE CAP AFTER THE CO2 CARTRIDGE HAD BEEN RELEASED. ONCE ALL OF THE GAS IS RELEASED INTO THE LIQUID YOU MAY THEN REMOVE THE TOP.** To release soda siphon head, simply do it in a counter- clockwise motion.
- Insert one CO2 into the cartridge holder then screw the cartridge holder onto the head of the siphon until a hissing sound is heard and the gas is released.
- After the CO2 releases into the siphon, leave the charger holder screwed on for 30 seconds.
- Shake the Soda Siphon well. Use one CO2 cartridge at a time and make sure **NOT TO REMOVE THE CAP UNTIL YOU HAVE REMOVED THE CARTRIDGE FROM THE SIPHON.**
- To gently dispense water, press lever & direct it towards the side of the glass.
- Press lever and direct it towards the side of the glass.



## 2 CLEANING YOUR SODA SIPHON

- Make sure that the soda siphon is completely empty. You can do this by depressing the lever before removing the siphon head.
- Unscrew the soda siphon head and remove.
- Take out the plastic sleeve from the siphon then rinse with plain warm water and allow all the parts to air dry.

## 3 USEFUL TIPS & REMINDERS

- It is best to use cold water.
- Put the soda siphon in the refrigerator, before and after use.
- If you want the sparkle to last longer, press the lever gently. This will allow control of the flow of the soda to the bottom of the glass.
- Make sure that the arrowed plastic sleeve is in position inside the siphon body before filling it.
- If the soda siphon loses fizz, simply shake it again.
- We do include a few extra rubber washers to use as replacements. After using the Soda Siphon you may want replace the washer.
- Please know that we provide extra o rings if they need to be replaced. The O ring is the one that is on the top of the insert that goes into the canister.
- When storing, keep all other parts disassembled.
- Rinse with warm water reusing the soda siphon.
- Do not use abrasive sponges or boiling water when cleaning your soda siphon. Warm water can be used when cleaning.
- Do not add flavoring syrups, juices, alcohol or other mixers into the soda siphon.
- Do not use more than one CO2 canister.
- Do not place it in the dishwasher.
